ALTITUDE: 4430 feet (1350 meters) above sea level

FEATURES: Characterized by cold nights due to the proximity of the mountains and altitude, it gives wines of great intensity in color, aroma and structure, destined for premium and aged wines.

FERMENTATION

The rosé must is obtained from the cold maceration in contact with the Malbec grapes for 24 hours.

Alcoholic fermentation with selected yeasts at a low temperature. No malolactic fermentation.

TASTING NOTES

Bright pink color. Fresh and sweet entry. Aromas and flavors of fresh red fruits with strawberry, cherry and strawberry. Delicate floral notes also appear. It is a balanced, pleasant and refreshing wine with good length and very tasty.
